Dear Secretary Bose:

The Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (Commission), in the above-referenced matters, issued an Order Approving Uncontested Settlement And Denying Rehearing (Order) on March 21, 2008 (122 FERC ¶ 61,257). In that Order, the Commission approved the creation of an Advisory Committee of the Organization of PJM States, Inc. (OPSI) 1 to “be comprised of five representatives selected by OPSI to provide advice to the Commission, MMU, PJM Board and PJM stakeholders regarding any matter concerning the MMU, market monitor, or the Market Monitoring Plan.”²
