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OPSI Welcomes Nomination of Colleague to FERC

The Organization of PJM States Inc. (OPSI) today welcomed the nomination of one of its long-time board members and a former president, Mark Christie of Virginia, to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

OPSI President Talina R. Mathews, a member of the Kentucky Public Service Commission, said, “Mark Christie has a long record of active leadership in OPSI. He was one of the original OPSI board members and served in that role for more than a decade.

“As president, he led the fight to ensure truly independent market monitoring in PJM and has remained actively involved as a member of the OPSI Market Monitoring Committee.”

“While we are always happy when a state regulator is nominated to FERC, this is the first time a former OPSI president has been nominated. We are pleased that FERC will have a member who has such a deep knowledge of OPSI issues and concerns,” Mathews said.

OPSI is comprised of the 13 States and the District of Columbia which participate in the PJM regional transmission organization and wholesale markets.
