NOTICE OF INTERVENTION AND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME OF THE ORGANIZATION OF PJM STATES, INC.

Pursuant to Rules 212 and 214 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("FERC" or "Commission") Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 212 and 214, the Organization of PJM States, Inc. ("OPSI"),¹ respectfully submits this Notice of Intervention and Motion for Extension of Time to submit comments in this proceeding.

I. MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

OPSI requests that the Commission extend the time for parties to submit comments in this docket through the close of business on June 20, 2023, which was the initial comment deadline in this docket.² Given the current deadline of June 9, 2023, OPSI requests a Commission order on this motion by June 6, 2023.

This filing has its genesis in an expedited stakeholder process at PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. ("PJM") that began on April 26, 2023.³ PJM Members then endorsed a package of reforms on May 11, 2023.⁴ Following this vote, the PJM Board of Managers met on May 22,

2023, to consider whether to file the package endorsed by the PJM Members Committee.⁵ OPSI, with two state commissions abstaining, wrote to the PJM Board of Managers on the same day expressing concerns with two of the three components of the endorsed package. OPSI declined to take a position on the third, which is the subject of this proceeding and revises the definition of an "Emergency Action."⁶ The PJM Board of Managers shared its decision to file with this Commission only the "Emergency Action" component of the Members' proposal on May 23, 2023.⁷

On May 30, 2023, PJM filed tariff revisions to revise the "Emergency Action" definition used for the purpose of determining Performance Assessment Intervals ("PAIs").⁸ PJM requested that the Commission rule on its request by July 14, 2023, and shorten the comment period to June 9, 2023 "as it would allow for a consistent application of the Capacity Performance construct" should a PAI be declared after June 1, 2023, which is the start of the delivery year.⁹ PJM also argues the Commission's expedited acceptance of its filing will reduce the uncertainty should PJM have to call a PAI after June 1, 2023 but before the Commission rules on PJM's proposal in this proceeding.¹⁰

Because of the expedited stakeholder process and expedited PJM Board decision that led to the proposal now before the Commission, OPSI believes it is reasonable for the Commission

to reinstate the original filing deadline in this docket of June 20, 2023. This would give retail regulators an adequate amount of time to fully consider the changes PJM is proposing.

OPSI does not take a position on when the Commission should rule on PJM's proposal.

II. NOTICE OF INTERVENTION

OPSI is an inter-governmental organization of utility regulatory commissions from the 14 jurisdictions located wholly or partly in the service area of PJM. OPSI's activities and actions include formal engagement at the Commission as well as engagement in the PJM Stakeholder process. As such, OPSI files its Notice of Intervention in the dockets above under Rule 214(a)(2), 18 C.F.R. §385.214(a)(2), of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure.
